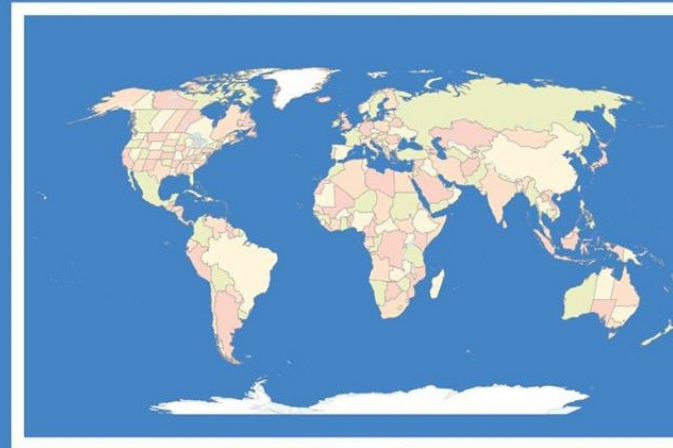
This process already started with the first meeting being held in Montenegro, 23-25 April in Bečići.
