

International team of history educators finish project on the history of migrants

THE HAGUE, AUGUST 31st 2011. A team of educators from over 20 countries have finished the 'Discovering Diversity' Project in August 2011. This project has focused on the history of migrants in the Euro-Mediterranean area. The project team has worked on the development of a methodology that helps history and civic teachers to connect the individual history of students to the local and larger history of migration in the Euro-Med region.

The educational material developed in this project is now available at www.discoveringdiversity.eu. The material will be the first content to be included in the Historiana website, which offers the first real alternative to the idea of a European history textbook. Several training sessions for educators are planned in 2011 and 2012. Professionals in history or history education are invited to help with the testing of the material from Discovering Diversity or to express interest in the development of more material.
