I have a MA in Romanian modern history with a thesis about the History Textbooks from 1883 till 1914. It is a continuation of the initial BA thesis about the Romanian History Textbooks from 1866 till 1883. I am not a teacher, but I have a huge experience in working with teachers (working on different subjects), students, parents and other beneficiaries/stakeholders as project manager. From 2003 till 2006 I was the Romanian coordinator (from Center Education 2000+) of the EUROCLIO project in Romania, Fostering History and Citizenship Education in Romania (the project was financed by the Dutch Ministry of Foreign Affaires through MATRA Programme and Open Society Foundation through Soros Foundation Romania). The EUROCLIO/CEDU project was a huge step forward in my professional career. I worked with a lot of very professional and very dedicated experts from Europe on history and citizenship education topic. Together with other Romanian experts, I coordinated the groups of teachers, monitors and authors who developed three educational materials during the project. I continue my work in the history field by coordinated the elaboration of other educational materials, as a guideline for teachers teaching history for students on 4th grade. After 12 years, I choose other career path, and starting with December 2014, I am working for the European Institute in Romanian which is affiliated to the Ministry of Foreign Affaires. My current job is very connected to the European Policies and Affairs. I am writing project proposals; I am doing fundraising and project management in the area of European Policies and Affairs.
