

Dear EUROCLIO members

Hereby we would like to inform you about the outcome of the voting for the proposal to change the membership fee system from 2012 on.

Of 65 members 37 have casted their vote: this is over 50%.

The result of this voting (taken into account the number of votes of each association) is:

Under the present Statutes all members were allowed to vote, as we don't have Internal Rules at this moment.

In the next GA we will propose Internal Rules in which is stated, that only paying members are allowed to vote.

But also if we would only have counted the votes of the paying members the majority of votes would have been in favor of the proposal (68% yes / 16% no / 16% abstain).

Since the majority of the votes are in favor, according to our statutes, the new membership fee system will start in 2012.

We believe that through democratic procedures and after discussion this is a fair and clear result.

With this new system we want to be more transparent and more fair in relation to the incomes of teachers in the different European countries.

Part of the new system is that we have included a procedure to inform the Audit Committee with regard to non-paying members and fees differentiating from the table.

We want to thank all the associations that have taken part in the discussion about the membership fee system and we hope to see you all in Antalya in 2012,
