

CALL FOR WORKSHOPS

WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

We are looking for inspiring, interactive and interesting workshops that touch upon the theme of the conference: Bringing History to Life - making history education meaningful to all students.

The workshops should:

- last maximum one hour and a half (90 minutes), including the time for Q&A and, if you would like, the collection of evaluation forms on the workshop;
- involve the participants to the workshop with an interactive element;
- be hosted in English;
- touch upon the theme of the conference or one of the following subthemes:
 - Looking at the impact of big events on ordinary people;
 - Using history to think about fundamental questions;
 - Linking history to current affairs;
 - Using popular history in the classroom;
 - o Using historical artifacts and visits to heritage sites to make history tangible.

WHAT DO WE OFFER?

If you are selected to host a workshop at the 26th EUROCLIO Annual Conference, <u>EUROCLIO</u> will cover your participation fee for one day of conference (the day of the workshop), amounting to 90 EUR. This discount is valid only if you are not eligible for any other discount. Accommodation and travel to the conference will **not** be covered.

SELECTION PROCESS and CRITERIA

EUROCLIO will review the applications and select the workshops for the 26th Annual Conference within two weeks (i.e. by Friday 14 December). Applicants will then be contacted and will receive information on how to proceed for the registration to the conference.

Selection will be based on motivation, experience, geographical balance, gender balance, and ability to contribute to the Conference programme with innovative and inspiring content.
