Phase 1 | Hosting school identification

DEADLINE – FEBRUARY 2023

Phase 2 | Schools matching

Schools will be paired based on the content and the topic of the project based learning activities carried out in 2022 or planned for the 2023

Phase 3 | eTwinning

During the period January-March 2023, teachers and students from the selected schools will have the opportunity to share documents and meet online in preparation of the mobility

Phase 4 | International mobility

The school visits and other international activities will be organized according to the availabilities of the sending and the hosting schools starting from mid-April 2023

All groups of Italian students and teachers **will benefit from the Erasmus+ grant** and we will support them with all logistic aspects related to the travel and the stay in the hosting Country
