



## KA 1 mobility

#### **Duration project**

#### 12-24 months

Start date: between 1 June and 31 December

#### **Duration of activity**

2 days – 2 months

• Consecutive days

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• Excluding travel days

#### **Eligible participants for mobility**

Staff in charge of school education (teaching and non-teaching, including <u>school managers</u>, <u>heads</u>, etc.), in a working relation with the sending school(s) as well as other educational staff (school inspectors, school counselors, pedagogical advisors, psychologists, etc.) involved in the strategic development of the sending school(s).

#### Schools apply for teacher training

#### **European Development Plan**

<u>Aim</u>: framing the internationalisation and modernisation objectives of the school within the proposed project.

It includes **identification of needs**, **outlining of plans**, and **integration** of the project **in the strategic development** of the school.





#### **Elements European Development Plan**

- Foreign language competences
- Raising awareness and understanding of other cultures and countries
  - o Build networks of international contacts
  - Develop a sense of European citizenship and identity
- Involving partner organisations active in different fields or sectors
- Better recognition of competences



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## **! Important: Dissemination (30%)**

- The quality of measures for evaluating the outcomes of the project.
- The potential **impact** of the project:
  - on individual participants and on the participating organisations during and after the project lifetime;
  - outside the organisations and individuals directly participating in the project, at local, regional, national and/or European levels.
- The appropriateness and quality of measures aimed at disseminating the outcomes of the project within and outside the participating organisations.



## **Include EUROCLIO activities**

Include your participation in EUROCLIO activities:

- Active involvement of history and citizenship teachers of the school to the EUROCLIO International Training Programme through participation in international training courses for history, heritage and citizenship educators.
- Exchange of information and practices with the EUROCLIO network of teachers from over 30 countries in Europe.
- Integration to the Historiana Community of Schools testing and piloting of educational resources developed within EUROCLIO cross-border projects and contributing to the development of <u>www.historiana.eu</u>.



## What is covered with the grant?

- **Travel costs** in lump-sum, depending on distance
  - <u>http://ec.europa.eu/programmes/erasmus-plus/tools/distance\_en.htm</u>
- Organisational support (€350 per participant) linked to implementation, such as pedagogical/intercultural/linguistic preparation, monitoring&support, validation learning outcomes, dissemination activities
- Individual support in unit-costs, depending on receiving country, including accommodation, food, accompanying persons
- Course fees (€70 per day, max €700 per person)
